Parental Code of Conduct

We are here to...

- 1. Provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parental Code of Conduct Pledge.
- 2. Not yell at or argue with referees.
- 3. Not force my child to participate in soccer.
- 4. Not behave negatively at games but to treat referees, opposing parents/coaches and opposing players with respect.
- 5. Learn the rules of the sport.
- 6. Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
- 7. Never use profanity.
- 8. Place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
- 9. Insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- 10. Support coaches and officials working with my child, to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- 11. Have a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- 12. Remember that the game is **for youth and is a recreational league**, not for adults or a club league.
- 13. Do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- 14. Ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, religion, color, creed, sex, or ability.
- 15. Help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.
