Hello GNW! For those who don't know me yet, I'm your Recreation Manager, Jacob Pena, writing to give you an update on everything recreation in the community.

First off, if you haven't been to our main office in a while, come on by and see our new Silver Creek Park! We had our grand opening ceremony back on October 19th, and the community members as well as Timberwilde students have been loving it! For now, it is just one large playground set, but our board of directors has plans to expand and purchase more equipment over the next couple of years. Such ideas consist of a covered pavilion with tables, another play set for younger children, a concrete path to our soccer fields, adult workout equipment, and swings! We plan to make this into a place where the community can come and enjoy a nice day out with friends and family!

I love soccer! I grew up playing soccer at GNW until aging out of the program and it is near and dear to my heart. So, it brings me joy to tell you that our soccer program is better than ever! New field layouts coupled with new goals and an excellent partnership with local soccer club Rush South Texas and Raising Cane's in Leon Valley have made for an exciting Fall 2023 season. We have over 220 kids on 18 teams in our program this season, which is on par with past seasons, but we will be looking at adding more kids to next year's season! We have 5 weeks left in this season so feel free to come out to one of our soccer games Friday nights at 6:45 pm or Saturdays 9:00 am-1:30 pm.

Lastly, our two big October events were amazing if I do say so myself. This year's 13th Annual GNW Car Show moved onto our soccer fields and I'm so glad we did. We saw our biggest turnout in a while, with over 70 cars participating and 775 attendees coming to the event. Guests were greeted with amazing rides and various foods provided by local vendors. We hope to make next year even better and utilize the whole soccer complex. Our 3rd Annual GNW Truck or Treat event saw a huge turnout! With over 2,200 attendees coming out to our event, it was the biggest single event turnout since I've been here. The resident fast pass line was a big hit as well seeing residents with their updated 2023 membership ID get priority entrance into the event. This was also the first year we held a costume contest for kids 18 years and under and it was a big success.








Dial-A-Trailer
