Parental Code of Conduct

We are here to...

1. Provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parental Code of Conduct Pledge.
2. Not yell at or argue with referees.
3. Not force my child to participate in soccer.
4. Not behave negatively at games but to treat referees, opposing parents/coaches and opposing players with respect.
5. Learn the rules of the sport.
6. Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
7. Never use profanity.
8. Place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
9. Insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
10. Support coaches and officials working with my child, to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
11. Have a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
12. Remember that the game is **for youth and is a recreational league**, not for adults or a club league.
13. Do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
14. Ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, religion, color, creed, sex, or ability.
15. Help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectable fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.
